



Our commitment is to the maintenance and adoption of the best corporate governance practices and, aligned with the idea of continuous improvement of our structures.


This report also reinforces Pacto Energia's commitment to be transparent, present relevant information and provide access to this information in a practical, objective and assertive way.

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Shareholders



Risk and Credit Committee: Analyzes, criticizes and approves updates to the credit risk exposure policy of our Traders. This committee also approves clients who may be an exception to the current policy. It is composed of a multidisciplinary team from the areas of marketing and finance.

ESG Committee: Analyzes, criticizes and approves projects in new business development or social support, discussing and evaluating their environmental and social impacts. It is composed of a multidisciplinary team from the areas of engineering, finance and HR of the Group.

Audit Committee: Monitor compliance with internal rules and current legislation in order to ensure the correct application. Analyzes and opines on relevant transactions outside the standard operational context. It monitors the complaints channel and formalizes an opinion on the reported complaints.

New Business Committee: Analyze, criticize and approve new projects and new businesses where the Group's resources will be invested, ensuring that resources are being allocated to projects that meet the interests of the Group, Shareholders and other stakeholders.



The Free Energy Market is an environment where companies can negotiate electricity through bilateral contracts with commercial conditions, terms and prices, freely negotiated. Unlike the captive market, where the consumer buys energy from regional distributors, in the free market, the choice of supplier focuses on the consumer's account.

Pacto Geração Distribuída

Pacto GD invests, builds and operates solar plants for low and medium voltage consumers, allowing them to offset their energy demand as a result of this generation.

The responsibilities of Pacto GD ensure that the Solar System operates at the maximum of its installed capacity and generates savings for the customer with its energy costs.

The market opportunity of the DG segment is driven by Brazil's high energy costs, allowing for exponential growth of the project.

Pacto GD targets 75 MW of new projects in the short term.

The GD business is synergistic with other elements of Pacto Energia's business model, including ePOP and EasySolar.

Pipeline includes projects with lease of the plants ranging between 10 and 15 years, covering customers from different economic sectors.


Pacto Geração e Transmissão

Pacto Geração e Transmissão is a company that invests, builds and operates power plants, transmission lines and substations.

We operate in the transmission and generation of renewable energy specialized in the development of greenfied projects.

In the centralized power generation projects under development, 7.3 GW were requested in grant applications from ANNEL, of which 4.7 GW have already been granted.

The power transmission projects consist of two substations with a capacity of 366 MVA, which guarantee a global revenue of around R\$ 310 million over 30 years through contracts with the federal government. Pacto G&T has an equity stake of 4.25% of these assets, with MEZ Energia as a partner. These assets start operating in 2023. In commercial operation, Pacto G&T has the CGH Salto, from Alemoa, with a power of 1MW.

EasySolar (Pacto Indústria Ltda.) is a company that carries out the commercialization, installation and legal and regulatory procedures of registration of generation plants with local energy distributors.

The company was responsible for the development of the 77Sol platform, a digital distributor of photovoltaic equipment.

The platform, which acts as SaaS (Software as a Service), operates as a facilitating link of the entire business chain (manufacturers, importers, distributors and integrators), from the import of equipment, to the delivery of generation systems to final consumers, providing tools such as purchasing and inventory management, systems sizing, proposal issuance, commercial monitoring, purchase of equipment, installation and even financial and administrative support to integrators, as well as financing marketplace for integrators' customers.



Services



Pacto Soluções operates in the management of generators, consumers and energy distributors, assisting them since the migration from the Regulated Captive Market (ACR) to the Free Energy Market (ACL), as well as the maintenance of their obligations with the CCEE (Chamber Commercialization of Electric Energy) and ANEEL (National Electric Energy Agency).

For generators, the company offers the services of consulting and market intelligence, negotiation and contract management, price analysis and regulatory advice. The company manages the energy of consumers with a specialized team, using innovative tools. It also meets the Pact Distributor with the demands with the CCEE.



Pacto EPC was created with the objective of performing engineering, construction, operation and maintenance services of power plants, transmission lines, substations and building infrastructure, as well as support services such as: gardening, cleaning, reception and concierge. 


Pacto Energia Distribuição Paraná is the company that distributes energy to the city of Coronel Vivida, located in the southwest of Paraná.
